

Silent Samaritan Breakfast Sponsor – Riverwalk Adult Day Services was a sponsor for SamaraCare's 12th annual Silent Samaritan Breakfast on February 26th at the Hotel Arista in Naperville. This event was attended by 220 guests and raised over \$47,000 to provide access to affordable mental health services at SamaraCare for women, and their children, in difficult financial situations.

Community Access Naperville - In February, while the nurses were at the center, we had a visit from the Community Access Naperville group, whose mission is to integrate differently enabled adults into the community. It was a tough bags competition, but the Community Access team prevailed!



Naperville Senior Task Force – Riverwalk Adult Day Services has met several times with the Naperville Senior Task Force (STF). The STF promotes coordination among existing senior service providers in the Naperville area; improves awareness among seniors of available resources to assist them; and develops recommendations to address service gaps related to transportation challenges, housing concerns and healthcare resources. Two of the major issues discussed during the meetings were affordable transportation and community education. 
